CRITERIA FOR JUDGES LISTS

A1 List

The A1 List indicates all persons whom the Club would support (this requires acceptance by the Club's judges committee) and who have been previously approved by the Kennel Club to award Challenge Certificates in the breed and who have carried out the appointment.

A2 List

The A2 list indicates all persons whom the Club would support (this requires acceptance by the Club's judges committee) who have been assessed in accordance with Kennel Club requirements and have been accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 list.

A3 List (Breed Specialists)

Requirements:

Minimum of 7 years judging experience in the breed and have the support of the WHWT Club of England.

1. To have judged at 1 breed Club Show.
2. To have judged the breed at 20 Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs with an adequate geographical spread.
3. To have judged a minimum of 60 classes.
4. To have judged a minimum of 200 dogs.
5. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they obtained their first entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (Save in exceptional circumstances).
6. To have attended at least 2 judging seminar/s and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.
7. To have stewarded for a minimum period of 3 years and at 12 shows (KC Policy).

A3 List (non specialists)

Requirements:

1. Minimum of 7 years judging experience in any one breed (to include 5 years in the breed) and have the support of the WHWT Club of England (KC Policy).
2. To have judged the breed at 20 Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs with an adequate geographical spread.
3. To have judged a minimum of 60 classes in this breed.
4. To have judged 200 dogs in this breed.

5. To have awarded CCs in at least one other breed (KC policy).
6. To have attended at least 2 breed judging seminar/s and passed an assessment where applicable.
7. To have stewarded for a minimum period of 3 years and at 12 Shows (KC Policy).
8. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs of any breed when they obtained their first entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (Save in exceptional circumstances).

B List (Breed Specialists)

1. To have 5 years experience owning and exhibiting in this breed and to have the support of the WHWT Club of England.
2. To have judged 15 classes of this breed at Open or Championship Shows without CCs
3. To have judged 45 dogs of this breed.
4. To have attended 1 or more breed judging seminar/s and passed an assessment where applicable.

B List (Non Specialists)

1. To have a minimum of 5 years judging experience in any one breed and have the support of the WHWT Club of England.
2. To have judged 15 classes of this breed at Open or Championship Shows without CCs (Save in exceptional circumstances)
3. To have judged 45 dogs of this breed.

C List (Breed Specialists)

For Aspirant judges who have shown an interest in the breed and have the support of the WHWT Club of England.
